PLEASE CONTINUE WEARING YOUR MASK & SHIELD**



The CTRC Management Team continues to work and meet regularly to monitor the Covid-19 situation, plan and respond to any issues, monitor the regulations applicable to our services and to communicate key messages.

In the communication today we want to focus on the situation of a CTRC staff who:

- a) has a member of their household potentially exposed to Covid-19 or
- b) has a member of their household undergoing covid-19 testing or
- c) has a member of their household informed by Public Health they are a close contact of a positive or presumptive positive case or
- d) has a member of their household presenting with Covid-19 symptoms

We ask all staff to comply with the following Ontario Government direction:

- ✓ Inform your employer/supervisor if any of the above applies to you situation in your household.
- ✓ **NOT vaccinated or only partly vaccinated Staff** (1 dose only or 2 vaccine doses and 14 days or less since 2nd dose) must call-in, and not report to work and:
 - Self-isolate for 10 days and even if you have a negative test during that time.
 - Return to work after 10 days and only if you have not developed symptoms or tested positive.
 - Resume workplace antigen testing.
- ✓ **FULLY vaccinated Staff** (2 vaccine doses and 14 days or more since 2nd dose) WHO have no symptoms must report to work and do the following:
 - wear a mask & eye protection and maintain physical distancing and
 - self-monitor for symptoms for 10 days and
 - self-isolate immediately if they develop symptoms
