The CTRC Management Team continues to work and meet regularly to monitor the Covid-19 situation, plan and respond to any issues, monitor the regulations applicable to our services and to communicate key messages.

- ✓ The need to wear a mask and eyewear in all residential home settings and at CSS remains in effect. We understand that easing of some measures are occurring across Ontario but our Ministry has been clear with the directive to continue wearing masks and eye protection in congregate care settings.
- ✓ Office and PRT staff are also required to wear a mask and to wear eye protection if within six feet of another person or when meeting with individuals for service.
- ✓ Supervisors, Managers and Directors will be addressing any observed laxes
- ✓ There are however positive signs of services returning to in-person including the gradual return of all PRT staff to their office locations and the gradual return of in-person CSS services.
- ✓ We understand that much has been and will continue to be requested of all our staff as we respond to both the ongoing pandemic and the gradual re-opening of services. Your efforts are so very much appreciated.
- ✓ We have seen the commitment by all our staff to protecting individuals in our care and protecting each other.
- ✓ We have recognized these efforts with pizza voucher, gifts baskets, and team lunches.
- ✓ Again this year we are bringing back Christmas basket offerings. Look out, shortly, for your selection form to complete and return to Human Resources.
- ✓ Lastly the 3 dollar per hours wage enhancement has been extended to March 2022.
