The CTRC Management Team and the Porcupine Health Unit continue to work on the pandemic response for CTRC Residential Services.

- ✓ The staff currently covering at Lawrence are upbeat and working well to ensure supports for individuals and each other during the outbreak.
- ✓ The outbreak period is set to end January 15th, 2022.
- ✓ The focus is on overall continuity of service across residential.
- ✓ We are also experiencing higher rates of sick calls and staff needing to isolate
- ✓ We are seeking, ahead of reassignment and redeployment, staff willing to be assigned at Lawrence until January 15th, 2022.
- ✓ Staff from other departments may put their names forward to work in any CTRC residential location, prior to reassignment and redeployment.
- ✓ We are looking to ensure the overall care, welfare, safety and security of individuals.

- ✓ Innovative and flexible scheduling will be considered.
- ✓ All overtime and long tours of duty provisions in the collective agreement will apply.
- ✓ Staff wanting to work and be put up in a hotel, to reduce potential transmission to their family, will be accommodated.
