RC ON CALL ENDING

WELLNESS CHECKS.

- ✓ As the number of Covid-19 cases are rising, the wellness checks remain a critical part
 of managing through this pandemic.
- ✓ All Staff must complete the Wellness Checks when reporting to their work location.
- ✓ Additionally:
 - a) if a household member is Covid-19 positive.
 - b) or you have been instructed to isolate by Public Health.
 - c) or you are returning from travel outside Canada AND are required to quarantine under Federal Quarantine Requirements.
 - d) or you have tested positive on a Rapid Antigen Test.

Please contact you supervisor or any other CTRC supervisor ahead of reporting to work if experiencing any Covid-19 Symptoms or if any of the above applies to you.
