**COVID-19 & PANDEMIC RESPONSE MEASURES
FULL VACCINATION REMAINS A BEST PROTECTION**

- ✓ Three (3) CTRC homes remain in Isolation/Outbreak.
- ✓ Individuals supported, who have Covid-19, are being closely monitored and they continue to fair well
- ✓ Staff with Covid-19 symptoms and/or confirmed Covid-19 remain absent from work and are using the supports available to them.
- ✓ The three (3) Infectious Disease Leave Days, provide by the Ontario government, remain available and accessible until July 31st 2022 for anyone that has not yet used any or all of these 3 days.
- ✓ The use of masks in the workplace remains.
- ✓ We will, on an ongoing basis, review masking best practices and make changes were able and feasible.
- ✓ The availability and the requirement to complete Rapid Antigen Testing (RAT) three (3) times a week for all residential and CSS staff remains in place.
- ✓ Any staff needing supplies or new record forms may contact myself.
- ✓ Visitors into the group homes and at CSS are required to complete RAT testing ahead of reporting to a residential location or CSS.
