The Cochrane Temiskaming Resource Centre (CTRC) is seeking a Professional Resource Team Clinical Director to join its team in Timmins.

CTRC is a regional Developmental Services provider offering programs across the Districts of Temiskaming and Cochrane including coastal communities along James and Hudson Bay. The successful candidate will work collaboratively within a multi-disciplinary team offering supports to individuals with Developmental Disabilities. The main responsibilities of the PRT Clinical Director would be to provide technical and clinical supervision in the management of the workloads of the Psychological Departmental staff providing eligibility assessments for Intellectual Disability/Developmental Disability and Behavioural assessment and intervention. To provide assessments and develop treatment strategies as per case and Centre requirements. Planning, organizing, administering, and directing the overall clinical operation of the Cochrane Temiskaming Resource Centre Professional Resources Team. To participate as a member of a multi-disciplinary team by providing supports, services, and programs to individuals with developmental disabilities as well as support to the families and other agencies who serve them.

Permanent Full-Time employees are offered a defined pension plan with the Healthcare of Ontario Pension Plan (HOOPP) and are enrolled from hire date. Extended Health Benefits (100% of drug costs) Life insurance, dental (\$1,000/yr), vision (\$225/24 months), para-medical coverage (\$21/visit/practitioner) and travel insurance are provided. Flexible work schedules are offered, including compressed work schedules and vacation is as per company policy. Ability to continue private practice is supported.

The successful candidate must be a Psychologist/Psychological Associate registered with the College of Psychologists of Ontario. Specific background courses and experience in psychological testing, behaviour intervention and applied behaviour analysis and dual diagnosis; experience in working with individuals with developmental disabilities would be considered an asset. Access to the Controlled Act of Diagnosis is required. Good written and verbal communication skills, as well as good leadership skills are essential. Ability to operate a computer and various software programs. The ability to work independently and as a member of a multi-disciplinary team are also important. At least 2 to 5 years of experience directing/supervising a large diversified staff in a unionized environment is sought. A valid driver's license and use of a car are necessary.
