The Cochrane Temiskaming Resource Centre (CTRC) is seeking a Development Consultant to join its team in Cochrane however travel to other service communities may be required.

CTRC is a regional Developmental Services provider offering programs across the Districts of Temiskaming and Cochrane including coastal communities along James and Hudson Bay. The successful candidate will be part of the Infant Development Program. The duties include intake for new referrals and consulting with the Supervisor; performing home and infant evaluations/screens through observation, administration, scoring and interpretation of the necessary developmental tests; developing and implementing individual plans for clients; working with families and educating them in early home based intervention strategies; assisting families in understanding their child's abilities, needs, behaviours and planning for their child's future needs.

Developmental Consultants will also work consultatively with other service agencies and providers, including Early Years Services, Community Living Associations, Schools and School Boards, Hospitals, and any other community based services part of the support network for individuals receiving services from CTRC.
