WHO WE ARE

The Cochrane Temiskaming Resource Centre (CTRC) is committed to providing support, services, programs, and resources to individuals with developmental disabilities and support to their families, schools and other agencies. We are a regional service provider operated by a voluntary Board of Governors appointed from across the Districts of Cochrane and Temiskaming. CTRC is fully funded by the Ministry of Children, Community & Social Services.



The **Professional Resource Team (PRT)** offers the following services for individuals with developmental disability:

Community Support Services Our Community Support Workers (CSW) advocate for adults and children. CSWs use a person centered approach to facilitate referrals, plan and coordinate services.

Psychological Services provides

psychological and behavioural assessments. Behaviour intervention services are individualized and based on applied behaviour analysis and a biopsychosocial approach.

Speech & Language Services provides assessment, intervention and consultation regarding communication disorders to meet the needs of individuals and their supporters.

Health Services is a clinical service that provides primary care to individuals residing in CTRC group homes. The health services nurse provides ongoing training and guidance to the staff to ensure continuity of care.
